Key Information:

- Successful players must be registered members of the Cessnock District Netball Association for the 2025 season. (Registrations will open in December 2024).
- Representative eligibility includes participation in a Cessnock Leagues Club team within the Maitland 2025 winter competition. We are open to new teams and individual players joining our Cessnock Leagues Club community.
- We will also offer a winter twilight competition from March to May and a summer twilight season from October to December at Cessnock.
- While we encourage players to engage in multiple competitions across the season, eligibility for the representative program specifically requires commitment to the Cessnock Leagues Club.
- Our representative teams will compete in Divisions 2 and 3 at the Hart State Titles in 2025, pending final grading by NSW.
- The representative training program will run from February to July, with sessions scheduled on Tuesday evenings. Pre-Season training and further training evenings may be scheduled at the discretion of coaching officials.
- All players must participate in scheduled representative carnivals and State Titles. Junior Hart State Titles will occur in early July (first weekend of school holidays), while Senior Hart State Titles will be held over the June long weekend.
